- what men can do to stop rape**

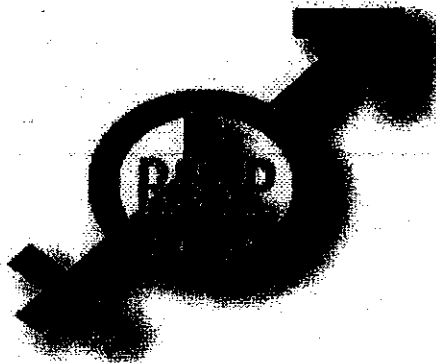
